Subject: How Will You Stay Informed About Emergencies?

Your safety is our top concern – that’s why Linn County wants to make sure you know about emergencies and incidents as they happen.

Linn County will use the NE Kansas Alert and Notification System powered by Everbridge to make sure you know about issues that may affect your safety. This system allows Linn County to contact thousands of residents in seconds so you can find out about an emergency right away.

Get up-to-the-minute information about severe weather, road closures, and much more!

Receive important messages from Linn County via email, phone, and much more!

How Does It Work?

The process begins when Linn County issues a message about a potential safety hazard or concern. Next, the NE Kansas Alert and Notification System sends a message through your primary contact path. If you don't confirm receipt of the message, the system will try to reach your second contact path and continues trying to reach you until you confirm receipt.
